-- Sebastian Aho posted an assist tonight for the second consecutive game (1/11-1/13: 2a).

-- Andrei Svechnikov tallied an assist tonight and has now registered points in back-to-back games (1/11-1/13: 1g, 1a). He has now earned 17 points in 11 games since returning from injury (12/19-1/13: 9g, 8a), with a point in nine of those contests.

-- Teuvo Teravainen registered an assist tonight, extending his point streak to three games (1/6-1/13: 1g, 3a).

-- Seth Jarvis recorded an assist tonight, and he has now posted 12 points in his last 13 games (12/15-1/13: 5g, 7a), including six points in his last six contests (12/30-1/13: 3g, 3a).

MEAN STREAK

With tonight's win, Carolina has now extended its season-long point streak to eight games (12/27-1/13: 7-0-1). The Hurricanes also improved to 10-1-4 over their last 15 contests (12/12-1/13), as their previous season-long point streak lasted six games from 12/12-12/21 (3-0-3). They have now earned a 2-0-1 record through the first three games of this season-long, six-game homestand (1/6-1/21), and they have now registered a point in 10 of their last 11 games at PNC Arena (11/26-1/13: 6-1-4), improving to 12-3-4 on home ice in 2023-24.

FEELIN' 22

Brett Pesce scored two goals tonight, including the overtime winner, for his first multi-point game of the season and the second multi-goal game of his NHL/Hurricanes career (also 1/12/23 at CBJ: 2g). His two goals topped his season total entering tonight's contest, as he scored just one goal over his first 33 games of the campaign (10/11-1/11: 1-4—5). Pesce has now scored three career overtime goals, including two against the Penguins (also 2/21/22 at PHI, 11/29/22 at PIT), and he has tied Anton Babchuk (2006-07, 2008-09, 2010), Dougie Hamilton (2018-21) and **Jacob Slavin** (2015-present) for the most by any defenseman in franchise history. Carolina has now improved to 4-2 in games decided in overtime, and 5-5 in games going past regulation. The Hurricanes had lost each of their previous five games going past regulation (11/30-1/6) after opening the season with wins in each of their first four such contests.

ANTTI HERO

Antti Raanta stopped 38 of 40 shots faced in net tonight, marking the most saves by any Hurricanes goaltender in a single game this season (previous: **Pyotr Kochetkov**, 12/27 at NSH: 35/37) and Raanta's most in any game with Carolina (previous: 37, twice). His last outing with 38 or more saves came with ARI on 3/10/21, when he stopped 44 of 46 shots in a 2-1 overtime loss at COL. Raanta has now posted a 9-5-2 record in 18 appearances with the Hurricanes in 2023-24, and he has earned a point in each of his last five games (12/15-1/13: 3-0-2). He has also played 35 regular-season games at PNC Arena since joining the team in 2021-22, registering a 28-3-4 record (.857) on home ice.

MARTY PARTY

Jordan Martinook scored Carolina's second goal tonight, giving him three points in his last two games (1/11-1/13: 2g, 1a). His two goals over this span have matched his prior season total (10/11-1/6: 2-8—10 in 40 GP), and he has now tallied four points in five games since the start of the new year (1/2-1/13: 3g, 1a), with the second-most goals of any Hurricanes skater in 2024 (**Andrei Svechnikov**: 6).

SOMETHING'S FISHY

Sebastian Aho recorded an assist against tonight, and he leads all Hurricanes skaters with 18 points over his last nine games (12/23-1/13: 3g, 15a). He has now registered 48 points (15g, 33a) through 39 games this season, which marks the second-most points by any skater through his first 39 games of a campaign in team history (since relocation). He trails only Eric Staal, who earned 52 points (26g, 26a) through his first 39 games in 2005-06.

SATURDAY NIGHT IN RALEIGHWOOD

Tonight's attendance was a sellout figure of 18,932. Including regular season and playoffs, this marks the Hurricanes' 40th consecutive sellout at PNC Arena (2/24/23-present). Carolina's last non-sellout at home came on 2/21/23, when a crowd of 18,142 watched the team post a 4-1 win vs. STL.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 0-for-3 on the power play tonight and is 40-for-142 (28.2%) on the man advantage in 2023-24. The Hurricanes went 4-for-4 on the penalty kill and are 114-for-137 (83.2%) on the kill this season.
- Pittsburgh went 0-for-4 on the power play tonight and is 19-for-137 (13.9%) on the man advantage in 2023-24. The Penguins went 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and are 103-for-125 (82.4%) on the kill this season.
