- -- Jaccob Slavin recorded two assists tonight for his fourth multi-point game and fifth multi-assist game of the season, and he has now posted three assists in his last three games (3/10-3/14).

FEELS LIKE THE FIRST TIME

Evgeny Kuznetsov (1g) and **Jake Guentzel** (1a) each found the scoresheet tonight, marking the first Hurricanes point for both players. Kuznetsov has now posted 18 points (7g, 11a) in 47 games with WSH and Carolina this season, and all seven of his goals have come at even strength. Guentzel has earned 53 points (22g, 31a) in 52 games with the Penguins and Hurricanes, and his 31 assists in 2023-24 trail only **Sebastian Aho** (43) for the most of any of Carolina's skaters.

STEADY FREDDIE

Frederik Andersen stopped all 21 shots he faced in net tonight to register his first shutout since 3/5/23 vs. TBL (14/14). He became the third different netminder to post a shutout with Carolina this season (also **Pyotr Kochetkov**: 3, **Antti Raanta**: 1), tied with LAK for the most in the NHL. The Hurricanes' five total shutouts are now also tied for the fourthmost in the league this season, behind only PIT (8), ARI (7) and VAN (7). Andersen has now earned a 7-1-0 record, 2.19 goals-against average and .913 save percentage in nine appearances in 2023-24, including a 5-0-0 record, 1.58 goals-against average and .934 save percentage in five games at PNC Arena. He has also posted a 3-0-0 record, 1.01 goals-against average and .955 save percentage in three appearances since missing 49 games due to a blood clotting issue (11/7-3/2), and his three wins trail only Marc-Andre Fleury (MIN: 4-0-0) for the league lead since 3/7.

PENALTY KILL

Carolina's penalty kill went 3-for-3 against Florida's third-ranked power play tonight, improving to 52-for-57 over the team's last 17 games (2/8-3/14: 91.2%). The Hurricanes have held the opposing power play scoreless in 17 of their last 22 contests (1/21-3/14: 63-for-70, 90.0%), and their 45 games without a power-play goal allowed in 2023-24 lead the NHL. Carolina has earned a league-best 90.6% penalty kill percentage since December (126-for-139), and the team's 85.4% kill rate this season (181-for-212) now ranks second in the NHL behind only LAK (179-for-207: 86.4%).

GOAL-ORIENTED

Andrei Svechnikov scored his 17th goal of the season tonight, and he has now scored four goals in his last five games (3/7-3/14: 4g, 3a) after posting a three-game goal streak from 3/7-3/10 (3g, 3a). The goal marked his fourth empty-net tally in 2023-24, the most of any Hurricanes skater and tied for the fifth-most in the NHL. Svechnikov has tallied a teamhigh 14 points (6g, 8a) in his last 13 contests (2/17-3/14), and he is also tied for the team lead in goals and assists over that span.

FULL HOUSE

Tonight's attendance was a sellout figure of 18,700. Including regular season and playoffs, this marks the Hurricanes' 55th consecutive sellout at PNC Arena (2/24/23-present). Carolina's last non-sellout at home came on 2/21/23, when a crowd of 18,142 watched the team post a 4-1 win vs. STL.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 0-for-5 on the power play tonight and is 52-for-203 (25.6%) on the man advantage in 2023-24. The Hurricanes went 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and are 181-for-212 (85.4%) on the kill this season.
- Florida went 0-for-3 on the power play tonight and is 59-for-220 (26.8%) on the man advantage in 2023-24. The Panthers went 5-for-5 on the penalty kill and are 185-for-225 (82.2%) on the kill this season.
