CRAZY EIGHT

The Hurricanes found the back of the net eight times tonight, tying the franchise record for most goals in a preseason contest since relocation. **Sean Walker** was the first star of the game with a goal and two assists, all coming in the second period. He recorded his first goal in a Hurricanes jersey on the power play in the second period, following it up with an assist on Jarvis' second goal and a secondary assist on Roslovic's power play goal. Walker has notched three points in a game once in his regular-season career at ARI on 5/5/21. **Shayne Gostisbehere** also recorded two points in his first preseason game as a Hurricane. Last season, he led all Red Wings skaters in assists and all defenseman in points. He has 270 assists in his career.

MAKING THEM PAY

Two of Carolina's goals came on the power play tonight, good for 40% on the PP in the contest. **Sean Walker** scored the first power-play-goal, followed by Jack Roslovic's unassisted goal with 28 seconds left in the second period. Roslovic had 0 PPGs last season and four PPP while Walker had one PPA in the 2023-24 campaign.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

Seth Jarvis, Sebastian Aho and **Jalen Chatfield** all recorded two-point second periods tonight. Jarvis scored two goals in the second after signing an eight-year, 59.36-million-dollar contract on 8/31 this offseason. Jarvis scored a career-high 33 goals last season, ranking second on the Hurricanes. Sebastian Aho had two assists in the second period. He matched his career-high in assists last season with 53, ranking first on the team in that category. Chatfield had two secondary assists in the second period. He signed a three-year, nine-million-dollar contract during the 2024 offseason.

FRESH FACES

Five players made their Hurricanes preseason debuts tonight: **William Carrier, Shayne Gostisbehere, Jack Roslovic, Josiah Slavin** and **Sean Walker**. Carrier, Gostisbehere and Walker all signed as free agents on 7/1, while Roslovic signed on 7/4 and Josiah Slavin on 7/7.

HOT START

Josiah Slavin scored his first goal in a Carolina Hurricanes' jersey in the first period. Slavin had 10 goals last season with the Toronto Marlies in the AHL and has yet to score an NHL regular-season goal. This is the first professional hockey game he has played with his brother Jacob, who was on the ice for his goal.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina went 2-for-5 on the power play tonight and are now 2-for-6 during the 2024 preseason. In 2023-24, the Hurricanes went 67-for-249 on the PP (26.9%), good for second in the league.
- The Panthers went 1-for-1 on the power play tonight. They were eighth in the league, going 63-for-268 (23.5%) last season.
