700 FOR NIKOLAJ

Nikolaj Ehlers skated in his 700th career NHL game tonight. Ehlers has recorded 16 points (5g, 11a) in 26 games so far this season, including the game-winning overtime goal in Sunday's 1-0 win over Calgary. He skated in his first 674 career games with Winnipeg, before signing with Carolina as a free agent on July 3 of this year.

SCORING SETH

Seth Jarvis notched his 16th goal of the season tonight in the first period, totaling 23 points (16g, 7a) in 26 games played so far this season and leading the Hurricanes in goals. He now has five goals in his last four games, including his second career hat trick on Friday vs. Winnipeg.

SLINGIN' SHAYNE

Shayne Gostisbehere provided an assist in the first period tonight and now has 19 points (3g, 16a) in 2025-26. Gostisbehere has six points in his last four games (11/23-12/4: 2g, 4a). The Pembroke Pines, Florida native entered tonight's game ranking second amongst NHL defensemen in points-per-game this season with 1.13. Gostisbehere (19 points in 17 GP) now needs only one more point to set the franchise benchmark for fewest games to 20 points in a season by a defenseman. The distinction is currently held by **Dougie Hamilton** (19 GP in 2019-20).

BACK TO SEA BASS

Sebastian Aho logged the second assist on **Seth Jarvis'** goal tonight and leads the Hurricanes in points and assists with 25 points (8g, 17a) in 26 games so far this season. Aho now has six assists in his last five games (11/21-12/4: 6a).

FILLING THE SEATS

The Carolina Hurricanes stretched their sellout streak to 130 consecutive regular-season and playoff games tonight. With the Lenovo Center undergoing renovations, the arena's capacity has changed to start this season and the seated capacity is now 18,299. That number will change again when the new View Bar seating opens on the 300 level during this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina was 0-for-3 on the power play tonight and are 10-for-76 (13.2%) on the man advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 2-for-2 on the penalty kill and are 61-for-76 (80.3%) on the kill this season.
- Toronto is 0-for-2 on the power play tonight and are 10-for-68 (14.7%) on the power play this season. The Maple Leafs are 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and are 63-for-77 (81.8%) on the penalty kill this season.
