-- Logan Stankoven (1g, 1a) stretches his point streak to four-straight games (1/3-1/8: 3g, 2a), the longest of his career.

-- Taylor Hall (1g, 1a) improves his tally to five points in his last four skates (1/3-1/8: 2g, 3a)

-- K'Andre Miller (1a) registered an assist to mark points/assists in back-to-back games (1/6-1/8: 2g, 2a) and six points in his last four skates (1/1-1/8: 2g, 4a)

STANKY LEGS

Logan Stankoven recorded two points (1g, 1a), stretching his point streak to four-straight games (1/3-1/8: 3g, 2a), marking the longest point streak of his career. He is also riding a three-game goal streak, which equals the longest of his career (2/26/24-2/29/24: 3g, 1a). The 22-year-old forward has registered 20 points (9g, 11a) in 44 games this season, including five multi-point outings. Stankoven is skating in his first full season with the Hurricanes, joining the club on March 7, 2025 via a trade with Dallas.

THREE CENTURY CHATTY

Jalen Chatfield has recorded two points (1g, 1a) tonight including the game-winning-goal in his 300th career NHL skate. The 29-year-old blueliner has recorded ten points (1g, 9a) in 37 games played so far this season, including points in back-to-back contests (1/6-1/8: 1g, 2a). Tonight marked Chatfield's first multi-point game since Feb. 8, 2025 vs. Utah (1g, 1a). His nine assists in 2025-26 are his most through 37 games played in his NHL career. Chatfield has recorded 67 points (22g, 45a) in 282 games played with the Hurricanes, joining the club on July 30, 2021 as a free agent.

MILLER TIME

K'Andre Miller provided the secondary assist on **Taylor Hall**'s empty net goal to mark points in back-to-back games (1/6-1/8: 2g, 2a) and six points in his last four skates (1/1-1/8: 2g, 4a). The St. Paul, Minnesota native has recorded 20 points (4g, 16a) in 36 games in 2025-26, skating in his first season with the club. Miller skated in his 400th career game on Jan. 1 vs Montreal.

HALL KNOWLEDGE

Taylor Hall (1g, 1a) recorded his fourth multi-point game of the season tonight, and second in his last three skates (1g, 1a on Jan. 4 at New Jersey). The Calgary native has tallied 22 points (9g, 13a) in 2025-26, including five points in his last four games (1/3-1/8: 2g, 3a).

FRED AGAIN

Frederik Andersen tallied 11 saves on 13 shots faced tonight, getting the win over his former club. Andersen appeared in 125 games for the Ducks from 2013-16, posting a 77-26-12 record, .918 SV%, 2.33 GAA, and 6 SO. Andersen was selected by Anaheim with the 87th overall pick in the third round of the 2012 NHL Draft. He appeared in his first NHL game with Anaheim on 10/20/13 and was named to the NHL All-Rookie Team that season after leading rookie netminders in wins and ranking second in goals-against average and third in save percentage.

GHOST STORIES

Shayne Gostisbehere recorded the secondary assist on **Jalen Chatfield**’s second period goal, marking points in back-to-back games (1/6-1/8: 1g, 1a). The 32-year-old blueliner has tallied 31 points (4g, 26a) in 32 games so far in 2025-26, leading the Hurricanes in assists (tied with **Sebastian Aho**). Gostisbehere entered tonight’s contest averaging 0.97 points-per-game this season, ranking sixth amongst all NHL blueliners.

NO FLY ZONE

The Hurricanes allowed 13 shots tonight, marking their fewest shots allowed this season and fewest shots allowed since Jan. 27, 2024 vs Arizona (11).

LOADING UP LENOVO

The Carolina Hurricanes stretched their sellout streak to 141 consecutive regular-season and playoff games tonight. With the Lenovo Center undergoing renovations, the arena’s capacity has changed to start this season and the seated capacity is now 18,299. That number will change again when the new View Bar seating opens on the 300 level during this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina is 0-for-2 on the power play tonight and are 26-for-134 (19.4%) on the man advantage this season. The Hurricanes are 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and are 98-124 (79.0%) on the kill this season.
- Anaheim is 0-for-3 on the power play tonight and are 24-139 (17.3%) on the power play this season. The Ducks are 2-for-2 on the penalty kill and are 113-147 (76.9%) on the penalty kill this season.
