DEFENSIVE MASTERCLASS

The Hurricanes allowed only 12 shots tonight, the fewest they have allowed since Jan. 27, 2024 vs. Arizona (11).

Carolina has let up a combined 25 shots in their last two games (13 vs Anaheim on Jan. 8) marking the lowest shot total through a two-game stretch in Hurricanes/Whalers franchise history.

HIGH STREAKIN STANKY

Logan Stankoven opened the scoring in the first period on a feed from **K'Andre Miller**, stretching his point streak to a career high five-straight games (1/3-1/10: 4g, 2a) and goal streak to a career high four-straight games (1/4-1/10: 4g, 1a). The 22-year-old forward has registered 22 points (10g, 12a) in 45 games this season, skating in his first full season with the Hurricanes, joining the club on March 7, 2025 via trade with Dallas.

SLAVIN'S RETURN

Jacob Slavin recorded his 300th career NHL/Hurricanes point tonight with the primary assist on **William Carrier's** game-winning goal. Slavin skated in his first game since Dec. 19 at Florida, missing the last ten contests with an upper-body injury. Slavin's assist was his first point of the season, skating in his sixth game of 2025-26.

MILLER TIME

K'Andre Miller provided the assist on **Logan Stankoven's** first period goal to mark points three-straight games (1/6-1/10: 2g, 3a). The St. Paul, Minnesota, native has recorded 21 points (4g, 17a) in 37 games in 2025-26, skating in his first season with the club. Miller skated in his 400th career game on Jan. 1 vs. Montreal.

STONE COLD SETH

Seth Jarvis logged an assist in the third period tonight to bring his season tally to 32 points (20g, 12a). The 23-year-old forward has recorded three points in his last three games (1/6-1/10: 1g, 3a) since returning from injury, missing the eight previous contests with an upper-body injury.

DARTH STAAL

Jordan Staal recorded two assists in the third period, marking his third multi-point game of the season and extending his assist streak to two games (1/8-1/10: 3a). The performance represented his first multi-assist game since Jan. 23, 2025 vs. Columbus (2a) and his first multi-assist period since March 10, 2024 vs. Calgary (2nd, 2a). Staal now has 19 points (10g, 9a) through 42 games in 2025-26.

LOADING UP LENOVO

The Carolina Hurricanes stretched their sellout streak to 142 consecutive regular-season and playoff games tonight. With the Lenovo Center undergoing renovations, the arena's capacity has changed to start this season and the seated capacity is now 18,299. That number will change again when the new View Bar seating opens on the 300 level during this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina is 0-for-1 on the power play tonight and are 26-for-135 (19.3%) on the man advantage this season.
The Hurricanes are 1-for-1 on the penalty kill and are 99-125 (79.2%) on the kill this season.
- Seattle is 0-for-1 on the power play tonight and are 28-123 (22.8%) on the power play this season.
The Kraken are 1-for-1 on the penalty kill and are 83-117 (70.9%) on the penalty kill this season.
