DYNAMIC DUO

Sebastian Aho and **Andrei Svechnikov** have factored on the same goal six times over the last three games. The duo factored on the same goal for the 152nd and 153rd times in their careers this afternoon, to pass **Ron Francis** and **Jeff O'Neill** for the fourth-highest total by a pair of teammates in Hurricanes/Whalers history. The top three is rounded out by Aho and **Teuvo Teravainen** (214x), Francis and **Kevin Dineen** (171x) as well as **Andrew Cassels** and **Geoff Sanderson** (163x). Aho provided assists on all three of Svechnikov's goals on Saturday, marking the Russian's fourth-career hat trick. **Andrei Svechnikov** has found twine in three-straight games (1/16-1/19: 5g, 2a) tying his career high goal streak (nine times, m.r. 12/20/25-12/27/25: 3g, 2a). The 25-year-old forward has recorded five goals over a three-game span for the third time in his career (m.r. 10/17/22-10/20/22: 5g, 1a). He recorded his 104th career multi-point game this afternoon to tie **Rod Brind'Amour** for sixth place on the franchise's all-time list. Svechnikov has logged 42 points (17g, 25a) in 50 games so far this season, ranking second on the squad in points. **Sebastian Aho** has notched 52 points (17g, 35a) in 50 games so far this season, leading the Hurricanes in points and assists. The Finn has provided assists in three-straight outings (1/16-1/19: 6a) and has 13 assists through 11 games in the month of January. Aho's seven assists in his last three games are his most in a three-game stretch since 12/27/23-12/30/23 (9a).

IN BUSSI WE TRUSSI

Brandon Bussi recorded 17 saves on 18 shots faced this afternoon, earning the win to improve his debut season record to 18-3-1. The 27-year-old goaltender earned his 15th career win (15-2-1 in 18 GP) vs. Dallas on Jan. 6 and has required the fewest games in NHL history by a goaltender to hit the mark. He hit the mark in one fewer game than Ilya Samsonov, Andrew Hammond, **Frederik Andersen**, Brent Johnson and Ken Dryden (all 19 GP). His 2.25 GAA ranks fourth amongst all NHL goaltenders this season (min. 14 games played).

JARVY PARTY

Seth Jarvis scored game-winning goal this afternoon, netting a power-play goal on feeds from **Sebastian Aho** and **Andrei Svechnikov**. Jarvis' game-winner marks his fifth of the season, the most by a Hurricane in 2025-26. The Winnipeg native has registered 37 points (22g, 15a) in 42 games played this season, leading the team in goals. His tally tonight gives him points in three-straight games (1/16-1/19: 1g, 3a).

BESTING BUFFALO

With today's win, the Hurricanes have earned wins in each of their previous 13 home games against the Sabres, which is the longest active home win streak in the NHL against a single opponent.

LOCKING DOWN LENOVO

The Hurricanes' win today stretches their home winning streak to five-straight games (1/6-1/19: 5-0-0), marking their longest of the season. Entering today's game, the Hurricanes let up a combined 41 shots in their last three home contests (12 vs. Seattle, 13 vs. Anaheim and 16 vs. Florida), marking the first time the Hurricanes have allowed 41 or fewer shots over a span of three home games.

FILLING THE SEATS

The Carolina Hurricanes stretched their sellout streak to 144 consecutive regular-season and playoff games tonight. With the Lenovo Center undergoing renovations, the arena's capacity has changed to start this season and the seated capacity is now 18,299. That number will change again when the new View Bar seating opens on the 300 level during this season.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina was 1-for-2 on the power play today and are 33-for-151 (21.9%) on the man advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 1-for-1 on the penalty kill and are 113-142 (79.6%) on the kill this season.
- Buffalo were 0-for-1 on the power play today and are 28-144 (19.4%) on the power play this season. The Sabres were 1-for-2 on the penalty kill and are 109-132 (82.6%) on the penalty kill this season.
