ON THE MARK

Mark Jankowski recorded an unassisted game-opening goal in the first period tonight, marking goals in back-to-back games (3/10-3/12: 2g). The streak ties the longest goal streak of his career, reaching that mark for the seventh time (m.r.-3/22/25–3/23/25: 2g). Jankowski has logged 16 points (7g, 9a) in 52 games this season.

STREAK SNAPPED

With tonight's loss, the Hurricanes' 12-game home points streak comes to an end (Jan. 6 - Mar. 10: 11-0-1). The run marked Carolina's longest home points streak since Jan. 14 - Mar. 18, 2022 (14 games, 12-0-2) and tied for the third-longest in franchise history (12 games, Feb. 20 - Apr. 7, 2009: 12-0-0). During the stretch at Lenovo Center, the Hurricanes outscored opponents 54-31 and outshot them 397-252.

FILLING THE SEATS

The Carolina Hurricanes stretched their sellout streak to 152 consecutive regular-season and playoff games tonight. With the opening of the new View Bar on the 300 level, seating capacity is now 18,547

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina was 0-for-2 on the power play tonight and are 44-for-198 (22.2%) on the man advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 1-for-1 on the penalty kill and are 144-181 (79.6%) on the kill this season.
- St. Louis was 0-for-1 on the power play tonight and are 29-171 (17.0%) on the power play this season. The Blues were 2-for-2 on the penalty kill and are 135-181 (74.6%) on the penalty kill this season.
