POWER PLAYERS

The Hurricanes have recorded a power-play goal in six-straight games (3/18-3/29: 8 ppg), doing so for the first time this season. The last time Carolina scored a power-play goal in six or more straight games was in the 2023-24 season, from Dec. 23 - Jan. 11 (8 GP). Since February 1, Carolina leads the NHL with a 30.8% power-play conversion rate.

GENERAL JARVIS

Seth Jarvis tallied an assist on **Andrei Svechnikov**'s first period power-play goal, giving him points in six-straight games (3/18-3/29: 2g, 7a), marking his second run of six or more games this season. He opened the campaign with a seven-game point streak (10/9-10/23: 7g, 4a), matching a career high. Jarvis has tallied 62 points (30g, 32a) in 65 games this season, leading the team in goals.

SVECH ON FIRE

Andrei Svechnikov opened the scoring for the Hurricanes with a power-play goal in the first period. The Russian forward has recorded 62 points (26g, 36a) in 73 games this season, marking the second-highest total of his career, trailing only his 69-point campaign (30g, 39a) in 2021-22.

SEA BASS SUNDAYS

Sebastian Aho picked up an assist on **Andrei Svechnikov**'s first period power-play goal, marking assists in back-to-back games (3/28-3/29: 2a). The alternate captain has logged 74 points (25g, 49a) in 73 games this season, including 15 points in his last 12 skates (3/4-3/29: 3g, 12a). Aho's 74 points equals his tally from last season, recording 74 points (29g, 45a) in 79 games played in 2024-25.

LOADING UP LENOVO

The Carolina Hurricanes stretched their sellout streak to 155 consecutive regular-season and playoff games tonight. With the opening of the new View Bar on the 300 level, seating capacity is now 18,547.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina was 1-for-3 on the power play tonight and are 52-for-220 (23.6%) on the man advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 3-for-4 on the penalty kill and are 166-207 (80.2%) on the kill this season.
- Montreal was 1-for-4 on the power play tonight and are 51-208 (24.5%) on the power play this season. The Canadiens were 2-for-3 on the penalty kill and are 173-226 (76.5%) on the penalty kill this season.
