SHORTY KINGS

The Hurricanes recorded their 12th shorthanded goal of the season tonight, passing the Calgary Flames (11) for the most in the NHL. The Canes have tallied shorthanded goals in three-straight games (3/31-4/4: 3 SHG), doing so for the first time in Hurricanes/Whalers franchise history. Carolina has tallied six shorthanded goals over its last seven games (3/18-4/4), tying their longest such streak in franchise history (also 3/31/06-4/11/06). The last NHL team with at least six shorthanded goals over a seven-game stretch was the Arizona Coyotes in 2018-19.

JIVIN' JARVIS

Seth Jarvis (2g, 1a) has marked points in back-to-back games (4/2-4/4: 2g, 2a) and 13 points in his last nine skates (3/18-4/4: 4g, 9a). The forward has tallied 66 points (32g, 34a) in 68 games this season, leading the team in goals. Jarvis' 32 goals are just one shy of his career high for most goals in a season (33g in 81GP in 2022-23). He has reached the 30-goal mark for the third time in his career, doing so in each of the last three seasons (33 in 2023-24 & 32 in 2024-25). He is the sixth player in Hurricanes/Whalers franchise history to register three straight 30-goal seasons; joining **Eric Staal** (4, 2005-2009), **Blaine Stoughton** (4, 1979-1983), **Sebastian Aho** (3, 2021-2024), **Jeff O'Neill** (3, 2000-2003) and **Sylvain Turgeon** (3, 1983-1986).

FLYING FISH

Sebastian Aho tallied a shorthanded goal in the second period tonight off feeds from **Seth Jarvis** and **Jaccob Slavin**. The Finn now has 78 points (26g, 52a) in 76 games this season, including points in five-straight contests (3/28-4/4: 1g, 5a). Aho extended his lead on top of the Hurricanes/Whalers all-time leaderboard for most shorthanded points with 37 (22g, 15a). **Rod Brind'Amour**, **Eric Staal** and **Dave Tippett** sit in second with 21 each. Aho's 22 career shorthanded goals are tied with Blake Coleman for the third most among active NHL players behind Brad Marchand (36) and Jean-Gabriel Pageau (24).

SVECH ON FIRE

Andrei Svechnikov notched an assist on **Seth Jarvis'** third period goal, stretching his point streak to four-straight games (3/29-4/4: 3g, 2a). The Russian has posted 66 points (28g, 38a) in 76 games this season, marking his second-highest goals, assists and points total of his career, trailing only his 69-point campaign (30g, 39a) in 78 GP in 2021-22.

LO-GANGSTER

Logan Stankoven tallied an assist on **Jackson Blake's** second period goal, extending his point streak to three-straight games (3/31-4/2: 3g, 1a). The forward has logged 37 points (17g, 20a) in 76 games so far this season, tallying his most

goals in a single campaign (14g in 2024/25 with Dallas/Carolina). Stankoven recorded two goals in the first period on Thursday, marking his first career multi-goal period, his first multi-goal game as a Hurricane and the fourth multi-goal performance of his career (m.r., 2/28/25 vs. LAK).

SPRING BLAKE

Jackson Blake found twine in the second period off assist from **Logan Stankoven** and **Taylor Hall**, marking points in back-to-back contests (4/2-4/4: 1g, 1a). The 22-year-old has logged 47 points (22g, 25a) in 76 games played so far this season, setting a new career high for points, goals and assists. He is skating in his second NHL campaign, posting 34 points (17p, 17a) in 80 games as a rookie in 2024/25.

HALL KNOWLEDGE

Taylor Hall notched an assist on **Jackson Blake**'s second period goal, tallying assists in back-to-back games (4/2-4/4: 3a). Hall now has 43 points (15g, 28a) in 76 games in 2025-26, passing his total from last season (42 points, 18g, 24a in 2024-25 with Carolina and Chicago). Since returning from the Olympic break, Hall has recorded 16 points in 19 games (2/26-4/4: 3g, 13a).

THE GOLD STANDARD

Jacob Slavin tallied a shorthanded assist on **Sebastian Aho**'s second period goal. The captain has recorded six assists in 36 NHL games in 2025-26. He now has 20 career shorthanded points with the Hurricanes, ranking third in franchise history (tied with **Andrew Cassels** and **Jordan Staal**). His 20 shorthanded points are more than double any other defenseman in franchise history. **Mark Howe** and **Joel Quenneville** rank second among blueliners with nine. The Hurricanes have posted a 26-6-4 record when Slavin is in the lineup this season.

KEY TO SUCCESS

K'Andre Miller tallied two assists tonight, giving him seven multi-point games this season. The Hopkins, Minnesota native has recorded 34 points (6g, 28a) in 68 games in 2025-26, marking the second-most points and assists in a single season of his career, trailing only his 2022-23 campaign with the New York Rangers (9g, 34a in 79GP).

IN BUSSI WE TRUSSI

Brandon Bussi recorded 13 saves on 16 shots faced to improve his debut season record to 29-6-1 and mark wins in four-straight games (3/20-4/4). Bussi is the fastest goaltender in NHL history to record 25 wins (29 GP), besting the previous mark set by Ross Brooks (32 GP, 1972-74). The 27-year-old goaltender has recorded two separate nine-game winning streaks this season, each tying a franchise record set by **Cam Ward** (9 games, 3/18/09-4/7/09).

LOADING UP LENOVO

The Carolina Hurricanes stretched their sellout streak to 157 consecutive regular-season and playoff games tonight. With the opening of the new View Bar on the 300 level, seating capacity is now 18,547.

SPECIAL TEAMS

- Carolina was 0-for-3 on the power play tonight and are 56-for-229 (24.5%) on the man advantage this season. The Hurricanes were 1-for-1 on the penalty kill and are 173-214 (80.8%) on the kill this season.
- New York was 0-for-1 on the power play tonight and are 38-228 (16.7%) on the power play this season. The Islanders were 3-for-3 on the penalty kill and are 167-205 (81.5%) on the penalty kill this season.
